75 of all americans approved of sending american troops to iraq in march 2003 gallup 2009 americans were told that the iraqi leader saddam hussein possessed weapons of mass destruction wmds and therefore was a threat to the united states however to date no weapons of mass destruction have been found in iraq although their alleged existence was one of the main reasons for going to war the bush administration managed to make the vast majority of americans believe this false assumption the goal of this paper is to explore how a u s president who was not considered a good speaker nevertheless succeeded in convincing the american citizens that going to war was the right thing to do in this paper it will first be briefly outlined what role presidential rhetoric plays then the post 9 11 rhetoric of the bush administration and its circumstances will be examined an attempt will be made to prove that the rhetoric of the bush administration was the key to the high level of support from the u s popula
