of the intellectual has shifted from an alienated nearly neocolonial stance to a position that allows him to celebrate intellectual activism and a return to the model of the oral vernacular intellectual even as he challenges other global intellectuals tracing the development of this notion of the postcolonial intellectual lovesey argues for ngô's rightful position as a major postcolonial theorist who helped establish postcolonial studies
