in jorge otero pailos installations the act of preservation is freed from its historic investment in stabilizing architecture in the ethics of dust he employs the cutting edge of conservation science to probe cultural political ethical and aesthetic definitions of architecture as it intersects with science and psychoanalysis

jorge otero pailos spain 1971 is an artist architect and preservationist based in new york from his formal education in architecture he creates works of art that address themes of memory history and transition inviting the viewer to see monuments as powerful agents that allow understanding questioning and connecting with culture otero pailos uses the material residues of modernity atmospheric dust waterways sweat traces and body sounds maps or even security bars to make their invisible meanings visible the ethics of dust is a site specific series of artworks where otero pailos transfers the pollution on monuments onto latex casts in an ongoing investigation of more than a decade the title of the series indicates a dialogue with john ruskin one of the founders of preservation each work in the series is distinguished by the subtitle which takes the name of the monuments such as the the ducal palace in venice westminster hall in london the u s mint in san francisco and trajan s column at the victoria albert museum in london

the explicit material gathers varied perspectives from the discourses of conservation curation and humanities disciplines to focus on aspects of heritage transmission and material transitions the authors observe and explicate the myriad transformations that works of different kinds manuscripts archaeological artefacts video art installations performances film and built heritage may undergo changing contexts changing matter changing interpretations and display focusing on the vibrant materiality of artworks and artefacts the explicit material puts an emphasis on objects as complex constructs of material relations by so doing it announces a shift in sensibilities and understandings of the significance of objects and the materials they are made of and on the increasingly blurred boundaries between the practices of conservation and curation
